S-290 Intermediate Fire Behavior: An overview of the information necessary to provide fire service personnel with wildland fire behavior knowledge applicable for safe and effective wildland fire management activities. Upon successful completion, the student will receive a S-290 certificate from the Stat Board of Fire Services. This course also satisfies the prerequisite for the new Wildland Incident Operations for Company Officer class (**Company Officer 2E**) required for the new SFT Company Officer Certification. Topics include; methods of heat transfer, relationship of flame height/length to fireline intensity, topographic influences on wildland fire behavior, temperature and humidity relationships, wind effects, weather observations etc.
