Company Officer 2E: An overview of the information necessary to evaluate and report incident conditions, analyze incident needs, develop and implement a plan of action to deploy incident resources, completing all operations to suppress a wildland fire, establishing an incident command post, creating an Incident Action Plan (IAP), and completing incident records and reports. Upon successful completion, the student will be awarded a completion certificate from the State Board of Fire Services.

Instructors:

Kim Thompson served 37 years with CAL FIRE and retired as a Battalion Chief in the Healdsburg Battalion. He served 9 years on a CAL FIRE Management Team as OP's Section Chief (4 Years) and Safety Officer (5 years). After retiring he has served as a Battalion Chief for Healdsburg Fire for 7 years and as SRJC Fire Academy Coordinator since 2011.

Marshall Turbeville is the CAL FIRE Battalion Chief assigned to the Russian River Battalion in Sonoma County. He is qualified as Operations Branch Director and Fire Behavior Analyst and has served on CAL FIRE Management Teams for 10 years in the Planning Section.

Steve Davis served 29 years with the San Rafael Fire Dept. retiring as the OP's Chief. He has served for 18 years as a member of Northern California Inter-Agency Incident Management Team 2 with 3 years as a Situation Unit Leader, 7 years in the Operations Section as a Division/Group Supervisor, and 8 years on the Command Staff as the lead Safety Officer. He has over 20 years of experience teaching NWCG, CSFM and NIMS courses.

Prerequisites: Fire 69 (S-290), FIRE 83 (CO2D), FIRE 290 (FFI/FFII) or equivalent

Procedures and Forms: During this unprecedented time, we are following SRJC, Local, State and CDC guidelines. Students will maintain social distancing and use masks when indoors.
